Authentic heraldry can be a very cost-effective way for a company or an organisation to obtain an impressive symbol for their business.

The Court of the Lord Lyon and the College of Arms grant arms to individuals and corporate bodies within their respective jurisdictions. Scottish clan societies and associations can petition the Lord Lyon King of Arms for a grant of arms, provided they are a reputable corporate body that has been in existence for at least three years and has a demonstrable connection to Scotland.

When you petition for a Grant of Arms from a recognised body such as the Court of the Lord Lyon or the College of Arms in the UK you will receive a document that is handwritten and illustrated with a depiction of the arms. However, when this illustration is photographed and reduced in size, it may not always be suitable for use in publications, advertising materials, letterheads, or business cards. Digitally recreating the arms with modern computer techniques is the best way to solve

this. It provides clear, crisp lines with vivid colours, which makes it ideal for heraldic illustrations. It also works well for flag design and gives excellent results when used for commercial printing. By using this method, it is also possible to give you a different rendition of your arms to that which was on your original document. Various permutations can be derived from the 'Complete Arms' artwork and saved as separate files. This gives you more choice and flexibility when using your Arms. The cost depends on the complexity of your blazon. (The written description
