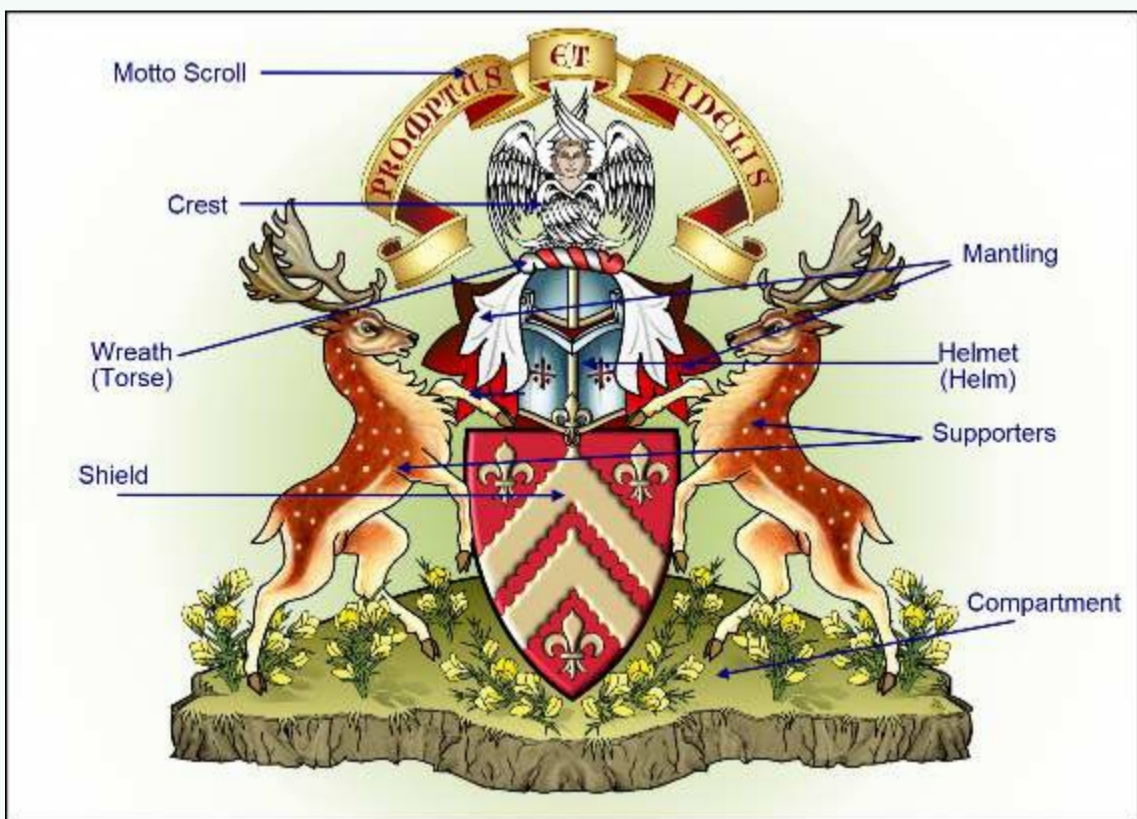

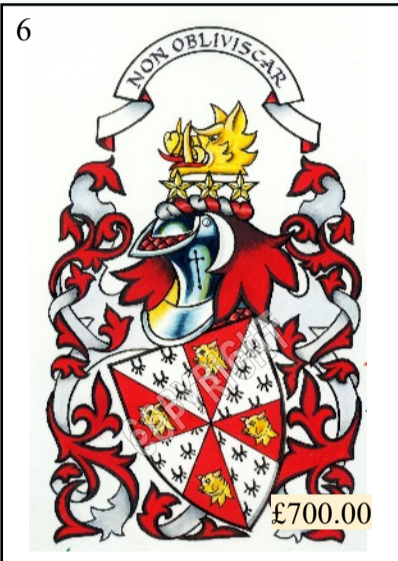
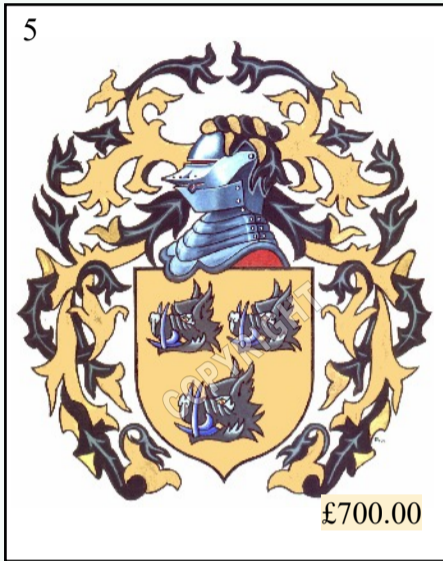


**PARTS OF A COAT OF ARMS or ACHIEVEMENT
(The Arms of the Chief of Clan Carruthers)**

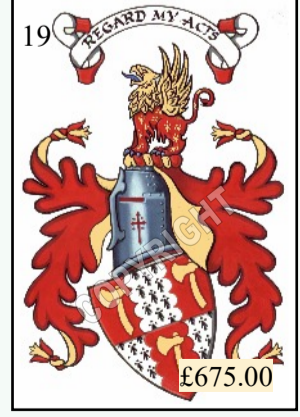
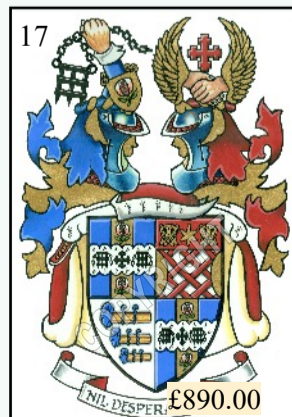
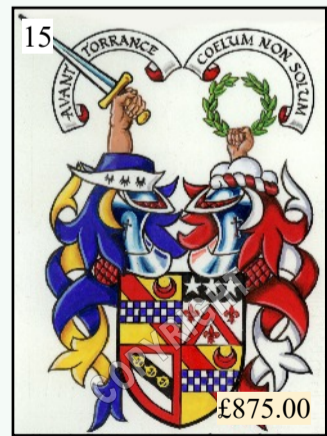
The mantling is the decorative 'cloth' which flows from the wreath on top of the helmet. The colours of the mantling are normally determined by the colours of the shield unless otherwise stated in the written description of your Arms (the blazon).

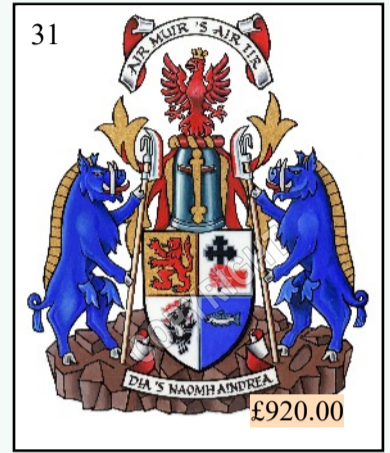
